



**Jacob D. rue Meslée**

**Suite of four chairs from the Empire period, stamped Jacob D. rue Meslée**

Gilded wood

In gilded wood, molded and carved with entangled oak leaves on the edge of the back, fleurons and lotus clasps, rosettes, palmettes and lotus leaves.

They stand on double-baluster front legs and saber-shaped back legs.

Stamped "Jacob D. rue Meslée".

The stamp "Jacob D. Rue Meslée" corresponds to the stamp used by Georges Jacob and his son François-Honoré -Georges Jacob dit Desmaller from 1803 to 1813.
